This is a combined Washing. Box and Negative Drying Tray. The tray that holds the plates can be lifted out of the tank when the washing is completed, and it becomes a perfect negative drying rack, avoiding an extra handling when the plates are in their most critical stage or liability of being damed where they have to be removed one by one from washing tank and placed in drying rack. The bottom of tray has alternate perforated slots, that permit an equal distribution of water, so there can be no spots possibly missed on a negative that will not get their share of washing. The water is admitted through a finnel-motel double discharging tube, and passes under and up through the tray and out through a drip tube on opposite end to funnel of tank.
